Venue and date

The Euro09 will be held from Tuesday, May 19 to Sunday, May 24, 2009 on the Lake of Constance in the area of Arbon, Switzerland.

Rules

- » The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF
- » The "Regulations for Europe Championships" of Swiss Sailing will apply
- » Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply
- » Rules of local authorities will apply from YCA

Eligibility

- » The regatta is open to boats from other countries
- » Competitors must be members of a Club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply

Advertising

Advertising Category A will apply.

Entry

Entries shall be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form, completely filled out and send out to the local class organisation.

The following documents shall be enclosed at the check-in:

- » Measurement Certificate or Certificate of Conformity
- » Confirmation of club membership or Licence
- » Confirmation of the legitimacy for advertising Category C
- » Confirmation of the third-party liability insurance

The Entry shall be submitted to: IPA or local class organisation.

Deadline for Entries: **April 19, 2009**

Entries shall be received by the organizing authority not later than April 19, 2009 (post stamp).

Scheduled Races:

The Championship will be sailed with 10 valid races. To constitute the Championship at least 4 valid races must be sailed during the scheduled time.

Schedule of Races

The check of the measurement certificates and the control measurements will take place in the tent next to the clubhouse.

No first measurements will be carried out.

Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System will apply.

Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded:

- » Championship Medals for the first boats
- » Prizes for different scenarios!
- » Souvenirs for each competitor

Mooring & Parking

During the Championship launching and hauling will be organized by the club. Before or after the Championship, please contact the harbour administrator.

Parking instructions for the competitors are available at the check-in.

Support boats

Support boats shall be registered at the race committee before the beginning of the event and comply with the support boat regulation for the championship. The authorization for navigation on the waters concerned will be obtained by the organizing authority.

Support boats will be part of the security arrangement for the event.

Social events and food infrastructure

The following events will be organized:

- » Thursday, May 21: General evening sponsored from Class Association "Nationenabend"
- » Saturday, Mai 23: Sailors dinner sponsored by YCA

Food infrastructure

- » Possibility for daily breakfast for CHF 7.00 / pers.
- » Possibility for daily lunch bags for the sailing crews CHF 7.00 / pers.
- » Dinner at the YCA for CHF 12.00

Registration for these events and services shall be submitted on the Entry Form.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event and valid for racing.
